Guide for international students

Who can apply?

All students who are aiming for a Bachelor, Master or State exam degree at the University of Bonn can apply for the Deutschlandstipendium. You can also apply if you are a high school graduate or prospective student who wishes to start studying at the University of Bonn at the beginning of the respective funding period. Funding is only available for the standard period of study.

Application process:

Applications are accepted between April 15, 2020 and June 5, 2020. Applications can only be completed online via the application server (https://bewerbung.dstip.de/uni-bonn). You have to register once on the application server. Please keep your login details safe. You can process your application within the application period at any time and upload additional attachments. A postal application is not required. The announcement of the grant or rejection of a scholarship will be made in mid-September 2020.

The following documents must be uploaded to the application server:

- Signed participation declaration
- Letter of motivation
- Tabular CV
- University entrance qualification*
- Complete performance overview * (if available)
- Certificate of study/enrolment (if already available payment will be made after submission of the current certificate of study)

The following documents can be uploaded voluntarily:

- Certificates for internships and part-time jobs
- Certificates for volunteer work, prizes, special awards and achievements, stays abroad etc.
- Application for support beyond the standard period of study

Please note that the application server is in German. You can upload all documents in English and fill out the fields in English. A language other than German or English is not permitted.

*For foreign certificates and performance overviews, it must be clear how the grade is to be classified. The certificate or the performance overview must already include a grading scale (i.e. grade A is highest grade, grade B is very strong pass etc.) or an official conversion table must be enclosed. Of course, you can also submit an official translation of the certificate or the performance overview, but this is not a requirement.
